



EXCURSION TO PEARL HARBOR

Heroes of the Sea

This morning, meet your Tour Director and travel companions for breakfast and a welcome meeting. Next, head out on a guided sightseeing tour that includes Pearl Harbor, the USS Arizona Memorial and Museum, the Punchbowl National Cemetery, Chinatown, the Hawaii State Capitol, 'Iolani Palace, and Kamehameha the Great statue. Tonight, enjoy an included dinner at your hotel.

SACRED SITE - Visit the National Memorial and learn about one of the most pivotal moments U.S. history. Cruise over to the USS Arizona Memorial and pay your respects to the 1,177 crewmen that were killed here on December 7, 1941. To this day, over 900 crewmen are entombed in the ship's wreckage 40 feet below the water here. You will also have an opportunity to visit the museum, an excellent way to learn about Pearl Harbor Day, the Japanese strategy and military craft, and the individuals involved in the attack.

DAY 4

HONOLULU-HILO-HAWAII VOLCANOES NATIONAL PARK-NA'ALEHU-KONA

Polynesian Pleasures

Board a morning flight to the "Big Island" of Hawaii. Upon arrival in Hilo on the east coast, drive to Hawaii Volcanoes National Park. Here, see Kilauea Crater, rising 4,090 feet above a volcanic wonderland of steaming fire pits, lava tubes, and fern forests. Next, enjoy an included lunch followed by a stop at Punalu'u Bake Shop to sample the famous Hawaiian malasada introduced to the area by Portuguese sugar workers in the 19th century. This traditional treat is not to be missed! Continue to Kona, your home for the next three nights.

LOCAL TASTES - Hawaiian malasadas date back to the 19th century when an influx of Portuguese sugar workers arrived in Hawaii. In 1952, the grandson of Portuguese immigrants from the Azores Islands, Leonard Rego, opened a bakery and was the first to use island fresh eggs to make them golden brown on the outside and light and fluffy on the inside. The bread has grown in popularity and is a must try when on the Hawaii!

This morning, visit the Kona Coffee Living History Farm. Tonight, join your Tour Director for a festive luau. You'll have the chance to learn to hula, try some traditional Hawaiian specialties, and see captivating performances by Polynesian musicians and dancers.

Next, view pretty 'Opaeka'a Falls on the Wailua River before continuing to your resort.

RUGGED BEAUTY - Kauai is Hawaii's fourth largest island and is also the oldest island in the Hawaiian chain. Known for its rugged lush landscapes, Kauai has areas that are only accessible by air or sea. This adventurer's playground has activities for everyone!

Gifts from the Earth

Drive to Waimea, once the Polynesian capital of Kauai and the site where Captain Cook landed in the islands in 1778. Sightseeing highlights include Waimea Canyon, the "Grand Canyon of the Pacific," and Hanapepe Valley. En route back to your hotel, see Spouting Horn, the famous blowhole created from a lava tube that sends plumes of sea water into the sky. Enjoy an included dinner at the resort and spend your evening on Kauai exploring further, relaxing at the resort, or indulging in some souvenir shopping.
